Specific Programme Sheet

NZ Certificate in Domestic Maritime Operations (Restricted Limits) Level 4

Completion of this course accredits you with a Certificated in Domestic Maritime Operations, which leads to Skipper Restricted Limits (SRL)

SRL is an entry-level command certificate with engineering components. This allows you to operate commercial vessels up to 12 metres (or up to 24 metres with endorsement) out to 12 NM in restricted limits

Pre-requisites

There are no entry requirements to join our course. However, MNZ require you to have 200 hours (about 25 days) of recreational or commercial seat time, prove that you are a Fit and Proper Person, have good eyesight and hold a Certificate of Medical Fitness for your final Certificate of Competency application. Check the MNZ website for further details.

Timeframe is up to 23 weeks which includes:

- **5 week full-time block course** and the completion of a student workbook prior to attending the block course, or
- Hybrid option with 7 day block course after completing the assessment blooks at home with guidance from your tutor.

The Training

In offering the NZ Certificate in Domestic Maritime Operations (Restricted Limits) Level 4, Skipper Training NZ is taking what we excel at: practical, excellent training; and responding to industry feedback and demand to deliver a full NZ certificate in a better way than the existing provision within the region.

You will complete your Training Record Book (TRB) in class with guidance of a tutor who will sign off your tasks. Our Managing Director invented this option, and it works really well for those who cannot access a vessel or a skipper at home.

The design of this programme is based on practical learning activities which reflect industry practices, knowledge, skills, behaviours and attitudes. All courses consist of structured learning activities aimed at achieving the MNZ Competency Framework competencies, overall learning outcomes, programme aims and core transferrable skills. These activities include reflecting on, reviewing and reinforcing tasks completed on the course both in the classroom and on the training vessel.

Topics covered on the course:

- General SRL Competencies
- Plan and Conduct a Vessel Passage
- Operating and Managing a Vessel
- Marine Safety and Compliance
- Marine Engineering
- Maritime Safety

The Skipper Training NZ staff will also be assessing you against the assessments linked to the MNZ SRL Competencies. There will be a final review of each Student's written work to ensure all work has been completed and assessed. There will be resit opportunities to complete any outstanding assessments, and this will also include self-directed revision time, with tutor support if required, preparing for the MNZ examination.
